### **About the Exhibition:**

The Magnuson Park Gallery, a division of the Sand Point Arts & Cultural Exchange (SPACE) is partnering with Plein Air Washington Artists (PAWA) to jury and present the 6th Annual *Plein Air Views of Washington* Gallery Exhibition. This exhibition features artists from all over Washington state, who have come together to present and celebrate artworks in the Plein Air style.

### **Exhibition Calendar:**

Entry Deadline: March 15, 2026

Acceptance Notice: April 5, 2026

Delivery of Artwork: May 14 & May 16 (for specific times, see below under pick up/drop off information)

Show Dates: May 28 - July 18, 2026

Opening Reception: May 28, 2026 from 5-8 PM

Paint out: July 18, 2026

Open Studios: June 6, 2026, from 12-4 PM

Pick up unsold art: July 18 & July 20

### **Entries:**

Two Plein Air paintings may be entered. The paintings must have been created within the past two years and have Washington State as the subject matter. They must be created in the Plein Air style (up to 25% of studio work will be considered Plein Air). The artwork must not exceed 11x14" (framing must not exceed 16x20). All submitted artwork must be available for show and sale.

Entries must be submitted through the Google Form. **There is no entry fee to participate.**

### **Exhibition Rules:**

- Paintings in oil, pastel, acrylic, watercolor, or gouache will be accepted
- Open to all artists 18 years and older. Teens who are interested in exhibiting must contact the Gallery Manager for an exception.
- Original art painted in Plein Air (on location). Works that have been modified up to 25% in-studio will be eligible. Paintings created in a workshop or while under the instruction of another artist are ineligible.
- Digital images are assumed to be accurate representations of the entrant's original art works.
- Paintings must be for sale and priced at \$100 (retail) minimum. The price you list for the artwork on your application must take into account the gallery's 30% commission fee.
- All artwork must be suitably framed, ready to hang; properly wired with strong wire and flat metal hangers.

- A 30% commission is retained by the gallery for all accepted art sold.
- Submission of entries grants SPACE and PAWA permission to include images in marketing and advertising, which include postcards, catalogs, websites, and all forms of social media.
- The gallery cannot accept deliveries or mail unsold artwork. If the location of the gallery prohibits your involvement in the exhibition, please email the Gallery Manager to discuss exceptions.
- Exceptions for deadlines, specifications or rules will only be made with email correspondence with the Gallery Manager. Submissions that do not meet the required deadlines, specifications, or rules without proper communication will be automatically ineligible.

**Jurying Process:**

A jury committee consisting of two Gallery staff/volunteers, up to five PAWA members, and three Sand Point Arts & Cultural Exchange (SPACE) board members will review all artwork submissions. This will be a blind jurying process, however, in-image signatures will not be omitted during evaluation. Jury members are not prohibited from submitting artwork for evaluation.

In-person artwork drop off during the time windows listed below is the Gallery’s preferred method of receiving your artwork. If dropping off your artwork in person prohibits your participation, **please contact us to arrange an alternate method of delivery.**
